Health Care Services Agency (HCSA) FY 2022-23 Proposed Budget Overview






FY 2022-23 Proposed Budget Highlights



- \$562.9M in community-based organization (CBO) contracts to provide behavioral health, public health and other health care services, including \$93.6M in contracts with Alameda Health System
- \$37M for Office of Homeless Care and Coordination
 - Home Together Plan
- CalAIM implementation
- \$43.8M for the new cycle of Measure A base allocation funding
 - \$5.8M increase from FY 22/23
- Phase III Santa Rita jail staffing



FY 2022-23 Health Care Services Agency **Appropriation by Type** (\$ in millions)




