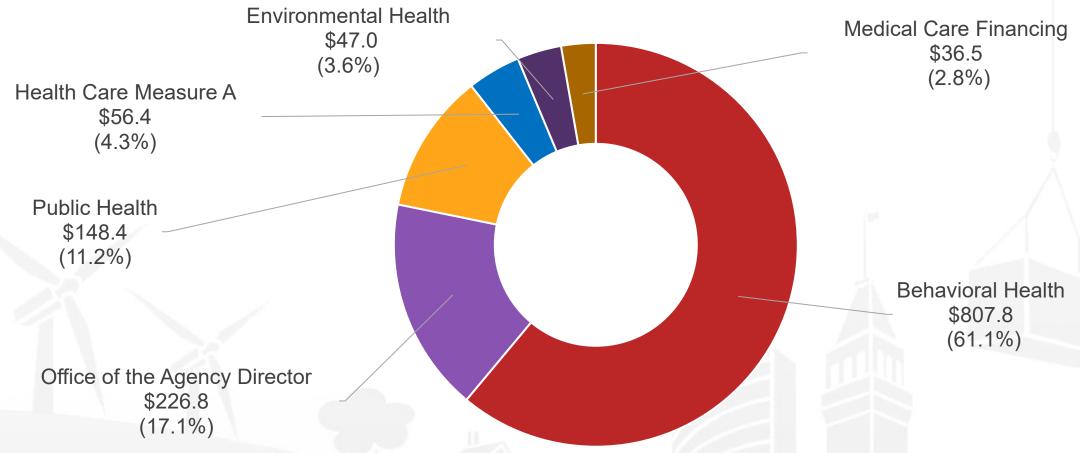

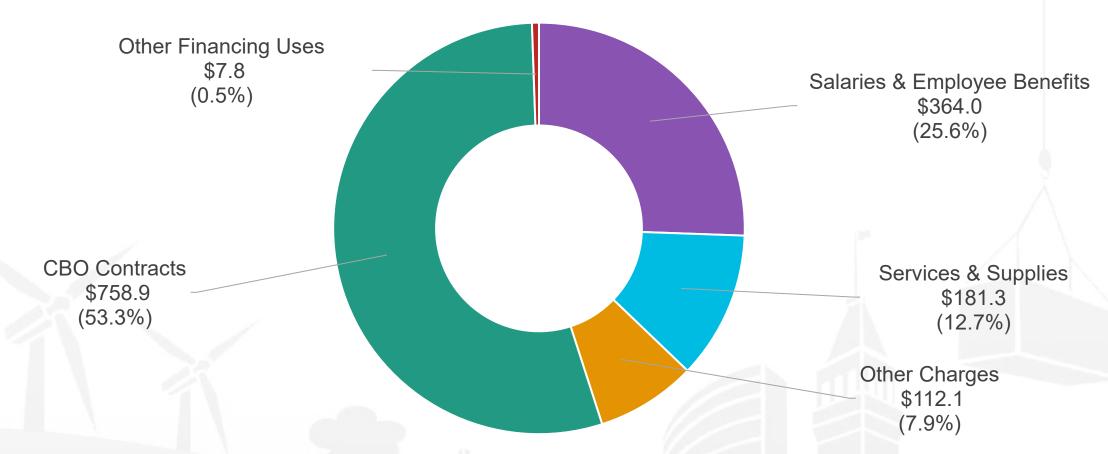

# **FY 2025-26 Health Care Budget Highlights**

- \$758.9M for contracts with community-based organizations (CBOs)
- \$123.7M for housing and homelessness services
- \$76.9M for the Health Program of Alameda County (HealthPAC)
- \$56.4M in Measure A funding
- \$31.9M for the Forensic Plan
- \$26.4M to support CARE Court implementation
- \$18.8M for CalAIM Community Supports and Enhanced Care Management
- \$14.8M for Environmental Protection
- \$5.8M for Public Health Accreditation



# FY 2025-26 Health Care Appropriation by Type (\$ in millions)



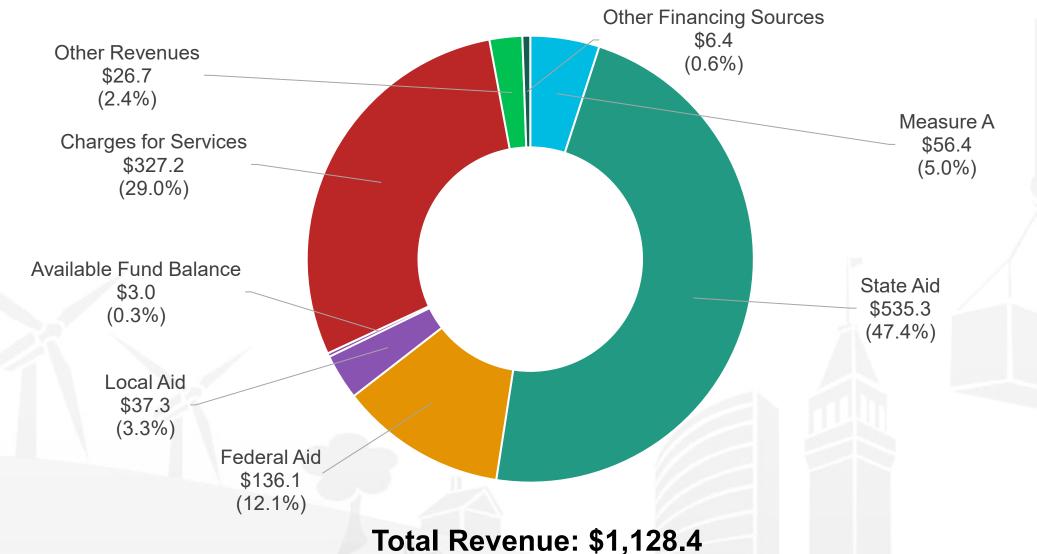

# **FY 2025-26 Health Care Budget Balancing Strategies**

Reductions	Net County Cost Change
Measure A revenue for HealthPAC	\$(4.2M)
Medicaid revenue adjustments	\$(3.0M)
Salary savings adjustments	\$(2.0M)
State Housing and Homelessness revenue adjustments	\$(1.5M)
Expenditure reduction due to prior-year savings	\$(1.0M)
2011 Realignment revenue adjustment	\$(1.0M)
Reduction of 5.00 vacant, funded FTE positions	\$(0.9M)
Adjustment to discretionary expenditures	\$(0.4M)
Total Reduction	\$(14.0)
